BC Company Fined \$20K for Diesel Engine Emissions Violation



Federal inspectors at the site of a BC machinery company performed tests on diesel engines imported from China. <u>Findings</u>: The equipment didn't meet federal emission standards for nitrogen oxides or non-methane hydrocarbons (NMHC). After pleading guilty to an EPA violation, the company that imported the engines was fined \$20,000 [*LP Projects Inc.*, <u>Govt. News Release</u>, Oct. 12, 2017].
