

# Company Pleads Guilty to OHS Violation in Boy's Death



A company was renovating an inn when a 12-year-old boy riding a bike nearby was struck and killed by a boom truck. The company was scheduled to stand trial on two violations of the *OHS Act* but opted to plead guilty to one charge. It'll be sentenced on May 9. On March 8, the court is expected to announce its verdict on OHS charges facing a dump truck driver, who was charged with failing to ensure safety on the site [5823 *NWT Ltd.*, Feb. 25, 2013].
