

Company & Supervisor Charged in Death of Bicyclist



A bicyclist was killed after being struck by an overhanging truss, which had been loaded onto the trailer of a delivery truck. The truck was on its way to a worksite at the time. The truss company was charged with violating the OHS laws by failing to protect people not in its employ.
