

Foundry Fined \$70,000 for Separate Safety Incidents



The first incident carrying a \$50,000 price tag occurred when a worker's hand got entangled during the cleaning of a walking beam used to move castings from one facility to another. The other incident, which happened about a year later, involved a worker who got hit by a tundish ladle that fell on him while it was undergoing maintenance work, resulting in serious injury and a \$20,000 fine [*Ancast Industries Ltd.*, Govt.
