Gasoline Release Results in Environmental Charges Against Five Companies



After an investigation into the release of gasoline at a gas station, the government laid charges against five companies under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, including releasing or permitting the release into the environment of a substance that causes or may cause a significant adverse effect and failing to report the release to the proper authorities as soon as it occurred [*Gas Plus Inc.*, *Handel Transport (Northern) Ltd.*, *Handel Transport Ltd.*, *Tank Testers Plus Inc.*, *and Tri-Con Transport Ltd.*, Govt.
