Maximum OHS Fine by Jurisdiction (for a first offence)

- TIE: 1. Ontario: \$1.5 million (corporation)
- TIE: 1: Sask.: \$1.5 million (corporation)
- 3. Federal: \$1 million and/or 2 years imprisonment
- 4. Alberta: \$1 million and/or 1 year imprisonment
- 5. BC: \$707,352.32 and/or 6 months imprisonment
- 6. Nova Scotia: \$500K and/or 2 years imprisonment (if fatality involved)
- 7. Northwest Terrs./Nunavut: \$500K and/or 1 year imprisonment
- 8. Yukon: \$250K and/or 24 months
- 9. Newfoundland: \$250K and/or 12 months
- 10. TIE: Manitoba: \$250K and/or 6 months
- 10. TIE: New Brunswick: \$250K and/or 6 months
- 12. Prince Edward Island: \$250K and/or 1 month
- 13. Quebec: \$60K (corporation)
