KNOW THE LAWS: Personal Privacy Laws

Here are the key privacy laws in each jurisdiction that apply to workers' personal information:

FED	<i>Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA)</i> : PIPEDA applies to all organizations engaged in commercial activities unless the federal government exempts an organization or activity in a province that has a law substantially similar legislation to PIPEDA
AB	<i>Personal Information Protection Act</i>
BC	<i>Personal Information Protection Act</i>
MB	<i>Personal Health Information Act</i> (applies to health-related information only)
NB	<i>Personal Health Information Privacy and Access Act</i> (applies to health-related information only)
NL	<i>Personal Health Information Act</i> (applies to health-related information only)
NT/NU	Don't have personal privacy laws
NS	<i>Personal Health Information Act</i> (applies to health-related information only)
ON	<i>Personal Health Information Protection Act</i> (applies to health-related information only)
PE	Doesn't have a personal privacy law
QC	<i>An Act Respecting the Protection of Personal Information in the Private Sector</i>

SK	Doesn't have a personal privacy law
YT	Doesn't have a personal privacy law
