Mine Pleads Guilty to OHS Violations in Worker's Death



A mine worker died after falling almost seven metres when the scaffolding he was working on collapsed. A second worker was seriously injured. The mining company pleaded guilty to three violations of the *OHS Act* for failing to ensure workers were made aware of health or safety hazards. It's scheduled to be sentenced on Dec. 19 [*The Iron Ore Company of Canada*, Dec. 6, 2012].
