The duty to post notices, information and other materials at your workplace for your employees comes in 2 basic kinds.

Rated load statement of a hoist from the manufacturer or engineer in a place where operator can see it while operating the hoist (Occup. Safety General Reg., Sec. 73(7))	
Maximum number of revolutions per minute of an abrasive wheel and grinder on the wheel or grinder (Occup. Safety General Reg., Sec. 97(1))	
"Danger — High Voltage" sign outside of electrical room where the components are rated at over 750 v phase to phase (Occup. Safety General Reg., Sec. 128(1)(c))	
Currently valid certification of confined space conditions (Occup. Safety General Reg., Sec. 131(3))	
Location of first aid supplies (Workplace Health & Safety Regs., Sec. 4.10.(3)(a))	
Name and location or phone number of first aid attendant(s) for the workplace (Workplace Health & Safety Regs., Sec. 4.13(3)(b))	
List of emergency phone numbers in first aid room (Workplace Health & Safety Regs., Sec. 4.13(1)(f))	
WHMIS placard instead of a WHMIS label OK for a hazardous product that is: (a) not in a container; (b) in a container intended for export; or (c) in a container intended for sale or disposition and is to be appropriately labelled in the employer's normal course of business and without undue delay; (d) in a container intended for use in the workplace and (i) the container is consumed in a production process, and (ii) the container or the hazardous product is identified through the use of colour coding, labels or any mode of identification clearly legible to employees, provided that the placard: A. discloses the information required on a workplace label; B. is of such size and in such a location that the information is conspicuous and clearly legible to employees; and C. is in such a location as to be clearly referable to the hazardous product to which it relates (WHMIS Regs., Secs. 10(1)-10(2))	
WHMIS placard instead of a WHMIS label OK for a hazardous product if employer ensures: (a) the hazardous product is in an area to which the general public and unauthorized employees aren't permitted access; (b) the product's container is identified via use of colour coding, labels or any mode of identification clearly legible to employees, provided that the placard: A. discloses the information required on a workplace label; B. is of such size and in such a location that the information is conspicuous and clearly legible to employees; and C. is in such a location as to be clearly referable to the hazardous product to which it relates (WHMIS Regs., Secs. 10(1) and 10(3))
