

Owner of Dry Cleaner Ordered to Publish Details of Waste Violations



During an inspection of a dry cleaner, Environment and Climate Change Canada enforcement officers determined that wastewater and residue generated by the dry cleaning machine hadn't been transported to a waste management facility. As a result, the company's owner pleaded guilty to two violations of the *Tetrachloroethylene Regulations* under *CEPA, 1999*. The court fined him \$10,000 and ordered him to publish the facts of the commission of the offence and details of the punishment imposed in a dry cleaning trade magazine [*Giuseppe Accardo*, Govt.
