Owner of Concrete Company Faces C-45 Charges



A 38-year-old concrete worker was killed when a concrete slab fell on the dump truck he was operating. In addition to OHS charges, the owner of the company has now been charged with criminal negligence under C-45 for his part in the fatality. A pair of supervisors also face OHS charges but weren't named in the criminal complaint [Boris Naneff, owner of Rainbow Concrete].
