

Owner of Roofing Company Fined \$23,800 for Worker's Fatal Fall



A worker employed by a roofing company fell from a ladder while trying to get onto a roof. He died due to injuries sustained in the fall. The owner of the company pleaded guilty to failing to ensure that all work at a place of employment was sufficiently and competently supervised resulting in the death of a worker. The court fined him \$23,800 [*Mike Molnar*, Govt. News Release, Dec. 13, 2013].
