Pulp Mill Charged with Environmental Offences for Substance Release



A pulp mill failed to immediately report the release of a substance to Alberta Environment. As a result, it was charged with six violations of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, including failing to follow safety rules while unloading a chemical from a truck. The mill was also charged with violating the *Dangerous Goods Transportation and Handling Act* [West Fraser Mills, Govt. News Release, Sept. 26, 2016].
