

Supervisor Fined \$22,500 for Migrant Workers' Deaths



Two migrant farm workers from Jamaica were trying to fix a pump for a vinegar vat when they were overcome by the fumes. They were removed from the vat with no vital signs and later died. A supervisor pleaded guilty to one OHS violation and was fined \$22,500. Charges against the farm operators were dropped [*Brandon Weber*, the Canadian Press, Jan. 11, 2012].
