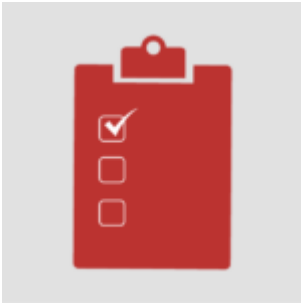


Tick Safety on the Jobsite



**One small bite can lead to serious illness.
Use this checklist to prevent tick-borne disease.**

BEFORE THE SHIFT

- JHA completed for tick exposure
- Workers trained on tick safety
- Long sleeves, pants, and light-colored clothing worn
- Repellent with DEET/Icaridin applied
- Permethrin-treated gear used when needed

DURING THE SHIFT

- Avoid tall grass and brush
- Take breaks in cleared areas
- Do regular tick checks during breaks
- Check gear and clothing for ticks

AFTER THE SHIFT

- Full body tick check completed
- Shower within 2 hours if possible
- Report and document any bites

□ Watch for symptoms for 30 days
