## Worker Charged with Murder in Stabbing Deaths at AB Work Camp



Workers may be at increased risk when <u>working alone</u> or in relative isolation, such as at a logging site or a <u>temporary labour camp</u>. For example, if workers get hurt while at such a camp, it may be difficult to get them appropriate medical treatment as quickly as possible. And isolated workers are more vulnerable to <u>workplace violence</u>.

For example, an Edmonton man was just charged with murder and other crimes in the <u>stabbing deaths</u> of two people at a work camp in northwestern Alberta. One of the deceased was a camp employee, while the other was a client. The attacker was also working at the camp. There were only 20 people there at the time of the attack.
