Worker's Fall from Roof Costs Employer \$70,000



A worker was seriously injured when he fell 12 metres from a roof while helping a co-worker operate a roof cutting machine. His employer was fined \$5,000 and, as a creative sentence, ordered to pay \$25,000 to the Bent Arrow program and \$40,000 to the Alberta Roofing Construction Safety Association [CCS Contracting Ltd., Govt. News Release, May 30, 2012].
