

Worker's Fall from Scaffolding Costs Employer \$7,000



A worker lost consciousness after falling three metres from scaffolding while working at a private residence. His employer pleaded guilty to failing to ensure a wood plank couldn't move in any direction that could injure a worker. The court fined it \$7,000 [*Robert Roy Carpentry Ltd.*, Govt.
