Companies have a duty to protect workers both while using equipment and machinery for their intended purpose and when repairing and maintaining that equipment. The primary way of fulfilling that duty is through what's called 'lockout,' which is when a equipment has been turned off and rendered inoperable with the use of a lock. So it's critical that workers understand the importance of lockout procedures.
