Workplace Posting Requirements OHS and Workers Comp Checklist – Québec



The duty to post notices, information and other materials at your workplace for your employees comes from 5 different sets of laws, including OHS and workers' compensation.

Use this checklist to ensure your organization has the required postings.

Notice saying employer has provided CNESST wage statements + reports required by Workers' Comp Act
