

Workplace Safety in the Oil & Gas Industry



The oil and gas industry is one of the more hazardous sectors in Canada. For example, in 2010, there were 16 fatalities in the upstream oil and gas industry in Alberta alone and 83 serious injuries in the industry in BC that year. So it's no surprise that workplace safety is an important issue in the oil and gas industry.
